



4th European Championship of Lusitano horses 2018 organized by Cavalo Lusitano Switzerland

24 to 26 August 2018

Horseacademy, Mooslargue, France

General terms and conditions

Only Lusitanos registered in the official studbook of the Lusitanos (APSL) are allowed. Each participant represents his country: the nationality of the owner of the horse is decisive.

At the Championships in each category (breeding show, dressage and working equitation) an individual European Champion will be chosen. At the Working Equitation a European Team Champion will also be determined.

In the breeding show classes, a national (Swiss) champion will also be chosen. He is the best Lusitano (mare or stallion) bred in Switzerland.

For the national ranking, the first three participants placed in each competition/category will be scored.

Each association is responsible for the selection in its own country. All participants respect the general rules of the APSL and the Swiss organizer (Cavalo Lusitano Switzerland).

The health and vaccination rules of the FEI (International Federation for Equestrian Sports) or SVPS apply:

- All horses must have basic immunisation against influenza. At least two vaccinations must have been carried out at intervals of at least 21 to a maximum of 92 days.
- All subsequent vaccinations must not be older than 12 months.
- Tetanus and herpes vaccinations are not compulsory, but are recommended.
- No vaccination less than 7 days before arrival at the event.
- Horses coming from a region where herpes or equine anemia or druse has broken out must not be stabled.
- The horses must not show any signs of disease.

All participating horses must present their passports before they are stabled: (Horse passport for identification, if necessary control of the microchip and control of the vaccinations.)

Appropriate measures are taken to minimize the risk of current herpes virus infections. The organiser will communicate appropriate measures in good time (depending on the situation in August).

Conditions for participation

1. The applications must have been received in due time (date: 15.07.2018).
Late entries are only possible with a handling fee of CHF 60.00 (EUR 50.00) per horse and subject to the pit quota.
2. All registrations must be made online at www.cavalo-lusitano.ch
3. All fees (entry fee and boxes) must be paid online at the time of entry (credit card, Paypal). Entries against invoices are possible in exceptional cases and only for an additional charge of EUR 15 per participant.
4. No fees will be refunded for cancellations after the closing date.
5. All horses must meet the categories according to the requirements.
6. the horses must be properly groomed and presented cleanly
7. The demonstrators/riders must be dressed correctly. It is allowed: Portuguese or English outfit, white trousers and white shirt are also allowed in the breeding show classes (presentation in hand).
8. Saddle and bridle according to the rider's equipment.
9. A vet check is provided for all participants. Participation is compulsory and a prerequisite for the start. The exact date will be announced in the time schedule. The vet checks start Thursday afternoon.
10. Arrival possible from Thursday, 23.08.18 from 12.00 h. Departure by Monday, 27.08.17 10.00 h.
11. For Swiss participants, a collective carnet ata for crossing the border will be provided. The corresponding registration form will be put online after the entry deadline.

Special conditions of participation for the licensing

1. Only Lusitanos in Swiss ownership are eligible to participate. Lusitanos with an owner of another nation only with special permission of the corresponding Association and Cavalo Lusitano Switzerland.
2. The horses must have a microchip implanted
3. A valid horse passport must be available for the horses.
4. for participating stallions a spermogram must be presented before (!) the licensing.
5. The horses undergo a detailed vet-check.
6. Mares are presented only at the hand for licensing
7. Stallions are presented under saddle in all three basic gaits according to the judges' instructions.

Prizes and Placements

- 1/3 of the participants will be placed in each category/exam.
- The classified participants will receive **prize money**.
- The best stallion and the best mare of all breeding show classes receive the title "European Champion Stallions" or "European Champion Mares".
- The best horse bred in Switzerland receives the title "Best PSL horse bred in Switzerland" and receives a trophy.
- The title "European Champion of Champions 2018" will be determined between the "European Champions". He receives a trophy.

European Champion of Nations:

The first three places in each examination or division/show class are counted (show, dressage, individual-working equitation):

1st place - 10 points

2nd place - 6 points

3rd place- 2 points

General information

1. Arrival from Wednesday, August 22, 2018 from 12.00 noon
2. Departure until Monday, August 27, 2018 until 10.00 a.m.
3. On arrival, the horse's passport (vaccinations) and the identity of the horse (microchip) are checked before stalling.
4. The boxes in the stables are labeled and may not be exchanged without consultation with the stable manager.
5. Mares and stallions are accommodated separately as far as possible. Wallaches can be accommodated anywhere.
6. Water is available in the boxes.
7. Forks and wheelbarrows are at your disposal.
8. Straw included. Chips for an extra charge.
9. Hay can be bought on site. EUR 15.00 per ball. Observe times!
10. Parking spaces for cars and trailers are available free of charge. The parking lot must be kept clean.
11. Campers cost EUR 60.00 for the whole duration.
12. The stable master and/or parking lot personnel are to be obeyed.
13. Dogs must be kept on a leash.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION CONCERNING HERPES CASES IN FRANCE

For **each horse** a health certificate must be presented, which is not older than one week. This also applies to all horses **from France** and the EU area.

For each horse arriving, the temperature is measured by an assistant before unloading. The horses **must remain in transporters** until they are released for unloading.

In case of increased risk in August, all boxes will be disinfected before the event. Horses may only be accommodated in the boxes assigned to them.

Horses with fever cannot be stabled. The further procedure will be determined in this case.

Tests – Sport

Dressage

General terms and conditions:

- Each rider can start a maximum of two horses per tour
- Only 1 horse per rider is allowed in each category. If a rider starts with two horses in the same category, he must indicate which horse will compete for the European Championship title.
- Each horse is only allowed to start in one tour
- The regulations of the Swiss Equestrian Federation SVPS apply.

Small tour consists of two tests.

Medium and Grand Tour consist of two qualifications and a final test.

In the final competition, only the eight best pairs from the addition of the scores from the first and second qualification are eligible to enter.

The final will start in the reverse order of rankings.

Points for dressage:

Each starter receives points according to his placement, which are multiplied by the respective factor.

The pair with the most points (from the two/three stages) becomes European Champion.

- 1st place: Points (=number of participants) plus 1
- 2nd place: Points (=number of participants) minus 1
- 3rd place: Points (=number of participants) minus 2
- 4th place: and so on...

Rating:

Small tour: 1st test (factor 1) / 2nd test (factor 2)

Medium and Grand Tour: 1st test (factor 1) / 2nd test (factor 1.5) / Final (factor 2)

Individual European Champion is determined in each tour.

Riding crop and spores allowed.

Judging: 3 judges, separate judging

The names of the team members must be announced when declaring their readiness to start. The other tabs only start in the individual ranking.
